sworn does depose and say:

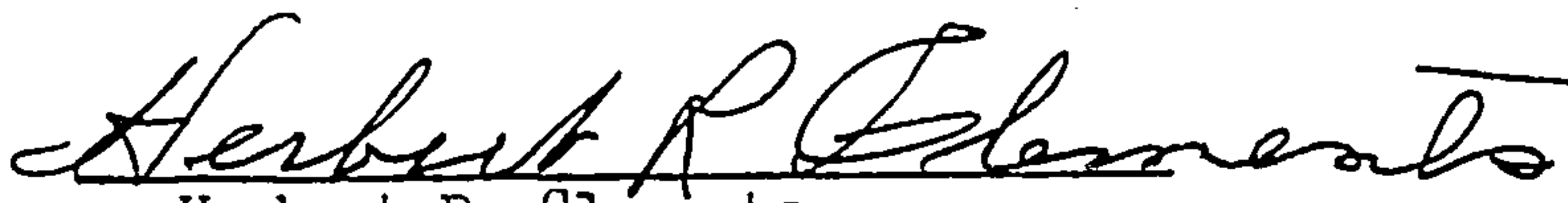
I am acquainted with the following described land:

SE 1/4 of NE 1/4; three acres in the NW corner of
the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, said three acres described
as follows: Begin at the northwest corner of the
NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, thence south along west line of
said forty 140 yards to a point, thence east
parallel to the south line of said forty 105 yards
to a point, thence north parallel to the east line
of said forty 140 yards to a point on the north line
of said forty, thence west along north line of said
forty 105 yards to the point of beginning, Section
18, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, containing
43 acres, and situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

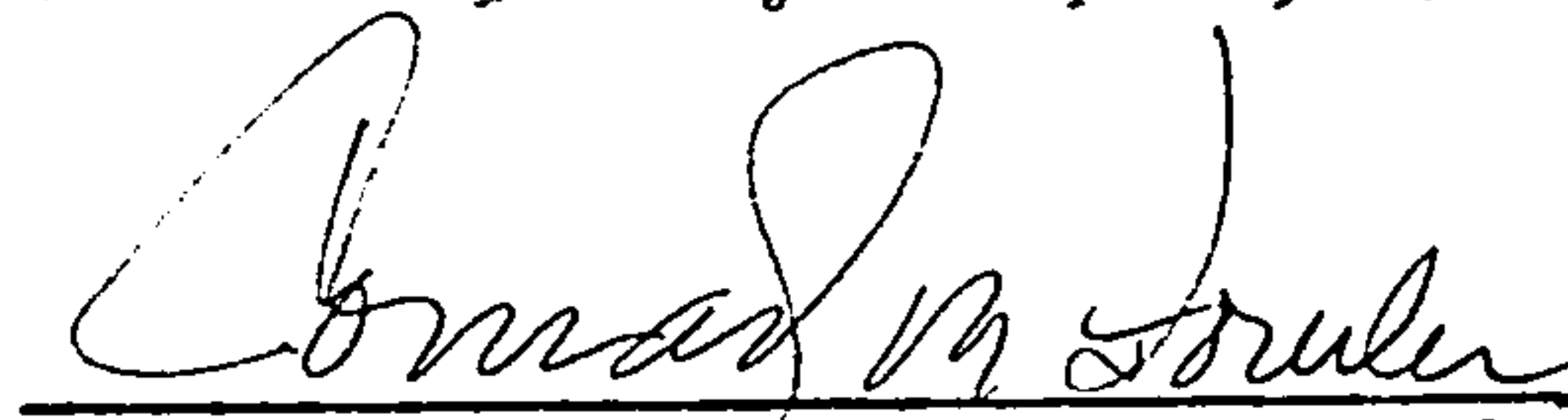
I acquired title to this property on March 19, 1941, from
Roxie M. Davis. Record of my deed appears in Deed Book 110, at page 530.
Within two or three months after purchasing this land I moved into a house
situated thereon and lived there until a day in December, 1951, on which
date the house in which I lived was destroyed by fire. I have assessed and
paid taxes on this land annually from date of purchase to the present time.

From the time of purchase until the date the house was
destroyed by fire I have had actual, open, continuous, notorious, exclusive,
peaceable, adverse and hostile possession of said property, claiming to
own the surface rights in the same against all the world. At no time has
my title or right of possession been questioned or contested by any party
whatsoever. From the time I acquired this land through the year 1951 I lived
on this land and cultivated portions thereof either in row crops or pasture
land each and every year.
