

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, [Signature] the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State, personally appeared Pearl Daviston, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Pearl Daviston. I am 69 years of age and reside at 116 South 57th Street, Birmingham, Alabama. I own the following described land:

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 22, Range 3 West, except the west 157 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards and except the east 55 yards of said forty acres; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

On November 22, 1927, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 84 Page 479 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, Sallie A. Ryan, an unmarried woman, conveyed to me the above described land, along with other lands. We just neglected to change the tax assessment record and on June 8, 1936, said land sold in the name Miss Sallie Ryan for nonpayment of taxes for the year 1935, as shown by Tax Sale Record 12 Page 223 in said Probate Office. My brother, Frank Harrison, and I redeemed said land from said Tax Sale. I understand the records show his name as Frank Harris. This was just an error as his name is Frank Harrison and he is the person who redeemed said land with me. The said Sallie A. Ryan did not own said land at the time it was assessed to her for the year 1935, but had already conveyed it to me in the year 1927, as mentioned above, and she did not claim to own said land at said time.

I am now a widow, my husband having died several years ago. My name is Pearl Daviston. My name has sometime heretofore been erroneously spelled as Pearl Davidson.
