whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Richard Harrison*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the tract of land of the said *Richard Harrison* as to which section one, of the act of the said Congress, is applicable

three (3) acres of the said *Richard Harrison* and a tract of about one and one-half (1 1/2) acres of the said *Richard Harrison*

which are covered by the said *Richard Harrison* and are now being returned to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been per-

mitted by the said *Richard Harrison*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Richard Harrison*

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and other

tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Richard Harrison*

and his heirs and assigns forever.
