To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas James S. McCallum Esq. of the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Philadelphia certifying that he has been appointed by the said State of Pennsylvania whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said State of Pennsylvania according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the State of Pennsylvania to receive the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars, and for the same to be paid to the said James S. McCallum, Esq., of the City of Philadelphia, in the name of the State of Pennsylvania, according to the official plan of the Survey of the said Lands, turned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James S. McCallum.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the above acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said James S. McCallum, Esq., the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and other conveniences, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said James S. McCallum, and his heirs and assigns forever.
