Samuel S Howard according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East quarter and the South West quarter of the North East quarter and the North half of the North East quarter of Section Twenty in Township nineteen of Range one West in the District of Columbia subject to sale at Tusculooa Alabama containing two hundred acres and forty two and a half hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel S Howard

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Samuel S Howard and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

Samuel S Howard and to his heirs and assigns forever.
