according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the East half of the West Main quarter of Section twenty-eight in Township Eighteen of Range one, Shiloh, in  
The District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Twenty-four acres and fifty-seven hundredths of an acre  
according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Phillips

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William Phillips and his heirs, the said tract above described, To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and other franchises, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said William Phillips  
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
