A short time before they deeded the property to John Sale they moved off of this property but had a tenant on it who lived upon it and had possession of it until it was deeded to John Sale.

Said John Sale went into possession of said property immediately after execution of the last mentioned deed to him and lived upon it and had actual, open, notorious, exclusive, continuous, adverse possession of the same until about July, 1951, at which time he sold or contracted to sell the property to William L. McGuire.
