Dollars (\$ 1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon, and counter-poise wires or

other counter-poise conductors under, a strip of land One Hundred (100) feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said Company, over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

East half of northwest quarter, northwest quarter of northeast quarter, southwest quarter, Section 19, also the northwest quarter of northeast quarter and the northeast quarter of northwest quarter of Fractional Section 30, all in Township 22 South, Range 3 West.

Said strip is approximately described as follows: Commence at the northeast corner of Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 3 West; thence run west along the north boundary of said Section 19, 2,606 feet to a point, said point being the point of beginning of right of way herein described; thence from said point of beginning 50 feet on each side of the following described center line and the continuations thereof, turn an angle of 65 degrees 47 minutes to the left and run south 25 degrees 42 minutes west 2128.5 feet; thence turn an angle of 9 degrees 00 minutes to the left and run south 16 degrees 42 minutes west 163.5 feet; thence turn an angle of 2 degrees 15 minutes to the right and run south 18 degrees 57 minutes west 1419.8 feet; thence turn an angle of 33 degrees 24 minutes to the left and run south 14 degrees 30 minutes east 1405.2 feet; thence turn an angle of 30 degrees 00 minutes to the left and run south 44 degrees 30 minutes east 1247.9 feet; thence turn an angle of 17 degrees 05 minutes to the left and run south 61 degrees 35 minutes east 350 feet to a point on the south boundary of Grantors' property, said point being the end point of right of way herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which said Company may from time to time exercise hereunder.
