Whereas James C. Hand, of Shelby County, Alabama,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE of Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

James C. Hand,

according to the provisions of the

Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter of the South West quarter, the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section thirteen, the East half of the North East quarter and North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section fourteen, in Township twenty one, of Range two, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, Containing one hundred and Ninety nine acres, and ninety three and one fourth hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said James C. Hand,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of Justice, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

James C. Hand

and to his Heirs, the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

James C. Hand

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
