has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa, Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James F. Underwood.

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for and into Acto supplemental thereto, for the fractional North East quarter of the North East quarter and fractions A and B, of Section nineteen and the South half of the South East quarter of Section eighteen and Township twenty-six South of Range one West of the Meridian Indiana in Alabama. containing two hundred and sixty-four acres

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said James F. Underwood.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of Gratus, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said James F. Underwood

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said James F. Underwood

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is issued in lieu of one dated June 17/508 which has been canceled and which
concerned a portion of the land as the South East quarter of section nineteen.
