

WARRANTY DEED.

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00)

Dollars, to them in hand paid, by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have this day granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, enfeoff and convey to the said party of the second part

all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Shelby and State of Alabama, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: The West half of South West quarter (1/4 of S 1/4) of Section Thirty two (32) in Township Twenty (20) of Range One (1) East containing Seventy eight ⁸²/₁₀₀ or (78 ⁸²/₁₀₀) acres

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above described tract or parcel of land, together with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging or otherwise appertaining, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part of the first part for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators, do hunc warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns from and against themselves, and all and every person claiming or holding under them, the said party of the first part, and against the lawful title, claim or demand of all and every person whomsoever, claiming or holding by, from or under the Government of the United States.
