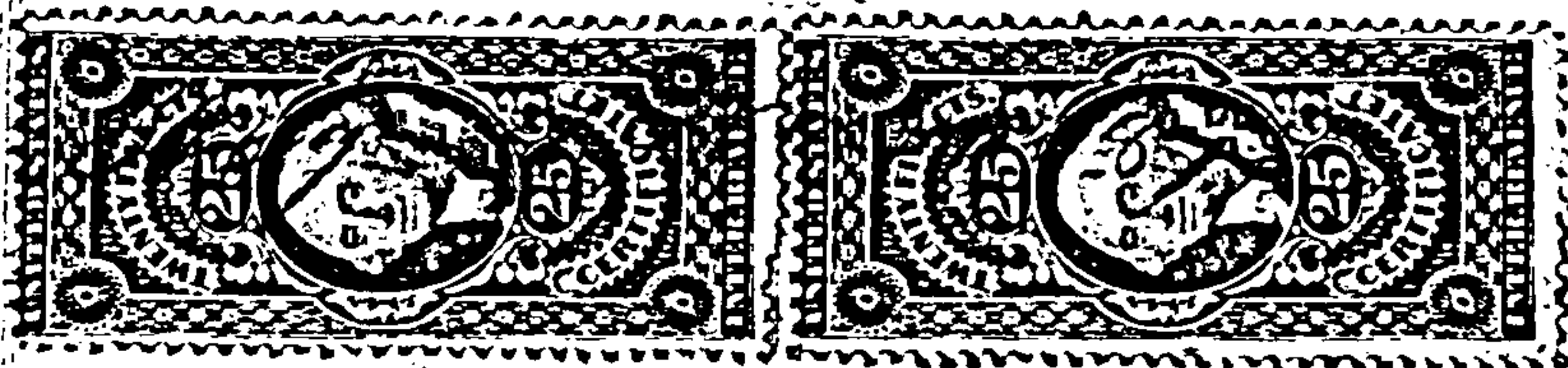

This instrument made and entered into this 9th day of November 1871 by and between Charles J. Hughes and Rachel Huse Husland and wife parties of the first part and Franklin Stinson party of the second part all of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have conveyed and sold and by these presents do again sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following described tract or parcel of land to wit The West half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty two Township Twenty of Range One East together with all and singular the land and appurtenances thereto in anywise appertaining unto the said issues and profits thereof to have and to hold unto the said party of the second part his

land and assigns forever and
 we further Covenant to and with
 the said party of the second part
 that we are lawfully seized in fee
 of said land and have a good
 right to sell and convey the same
 and that we will perform warrant
 and beyond the better thereof against
 all and every person both in
 law and equity and also against
 the government of the United
 States of America
