Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Marshall Giangrosso and Mike Ross, each being first duly sworn, denoses and says that he resides in Jefferson County, Alabama; that Marshall Giangrosso is a son-in-law, and Mike Ross is the husband of Nellie Ross, who departed this life, intestate, in Jefferson County, Alabama, on March 19, 1948, and that said decedent left surviving her as her sole heirs-at-law and next of kin, the following, each of whom was over the age of twenty-one years on the date of the death of the said Nellie Ross, namely: Mary Ross Giangrosso, Julia Ross Shaver, Andy Ross, Bridgie Ross Stamps, Feora Ross, Rosa Ross Gonzales, and Mike Ross, Jr.

Affiants further say that the said Nellie Ross owned an undivided interest in the following lands, to wit,

Affiants further say that the grantors in that certain deed dated April 15, 1949, executed by Bridgie Ross Stamps, and others, conveying the above described lands, were all of the heirs at law and next of kin, and their husbands and wives, respectively, of the said Nellie Ross, deceased, said deed being of record in Deed Book 138, on page 506 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiants further say that there has been no Letters of Administration issued on the Estate of the said Nellie Ross, none being necessary since the Estate of said decedent owed no debts.

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Affiants further say that Thomas Stamps, being the one and same person as Thomas Greely Stamps, owned no interest in the above described lands; he joined in the deed with his wife, Bridgie Ross Stamps, conveying his wife's interest in the lands as one of the heirs of the said decedent, Nellie Ross.

Affiants further say of their own personal knowledge that they know that for the last past twenty-five years, Marshall Giangrosso and Mike Ross, and those through whom the said Marshall Giangrosso and Mike Ross hold title to the above described lands, have been, respectively, in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceable, and adverse possession of said lands, claiming said lands as their own, respectively, against all the world, and regularly exercising acts of ownership over said lands; that affiants have never heard their title to the said lands, or those through whom they hold title to said lands, to be questioned in any way.
