K. Godwin. He acquired title to this land on March 2, 1887, according to a
deed which appears of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County,
Alabama, in Deed Book 10 at page 377.

Phebe K. Godwin died in 1939. My father, the husband of Phebe K. Godwin, died five months later. Neither my father nor mother left a Will, nor was there an administration of their estate. Jack Godwin and I were the only children of Phebe K. Godwin and her husband.

My brother and I conveyed it to Shelby Iron Company in 1942 and this company in turn re-conveyed this property to my husband, Johnnie Farr, and I on December 7, 1946.
