The South half of Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter and the North half of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 18, Range 2 East and the North half of Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter and the West half of Southwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 18, Range 1 East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, to the said Hazel Whitfield, her heirs and assigns forever.
