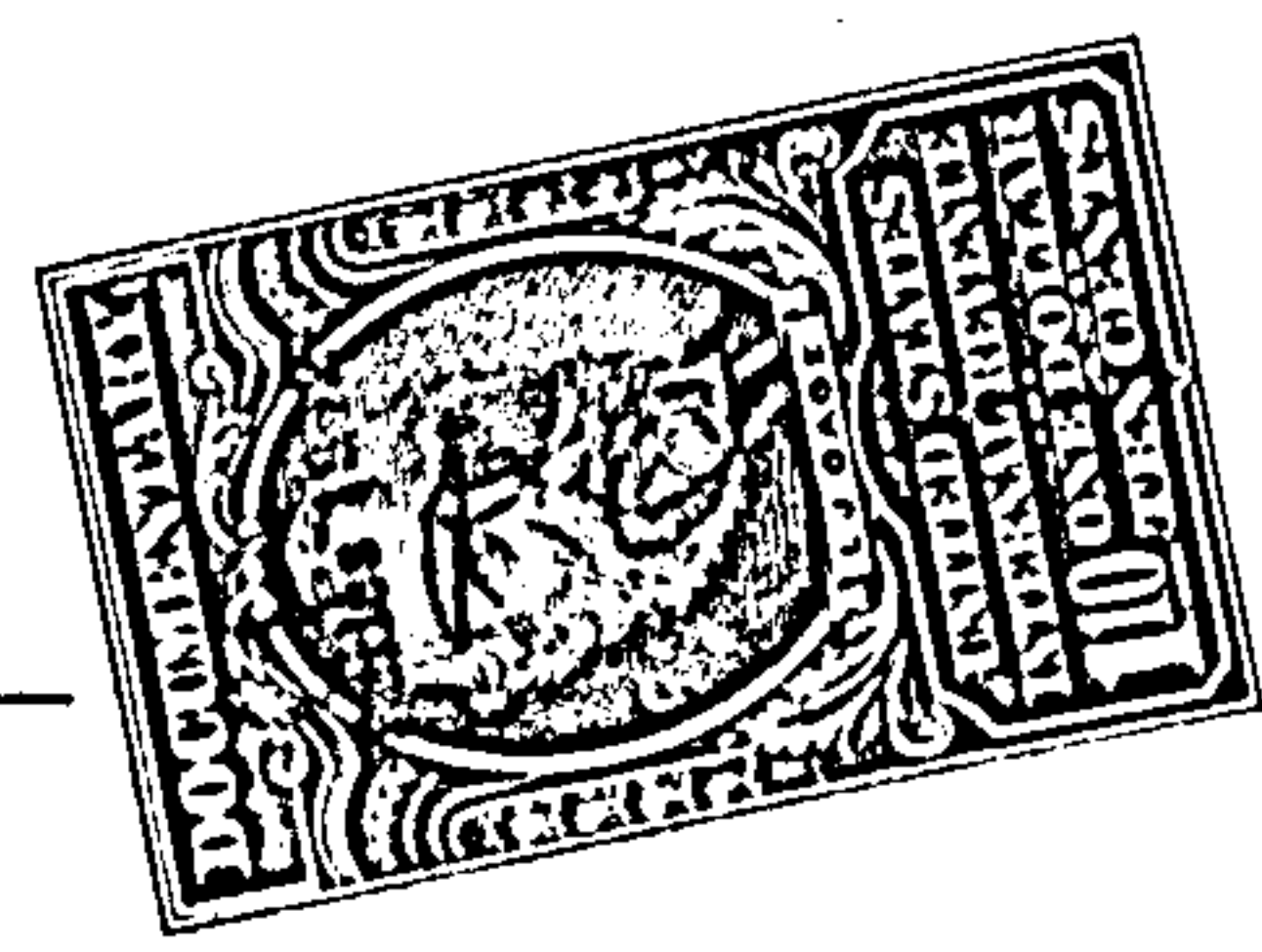


WARRANTY DEED

quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 10-
Township 20, South of Range One East.
Containing 40 Acres more or less.
Except a strip 25 ft. wide off of the
North side of said forty Acres to be
used for a road.

Also: Part of N.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Section 9,
Township 20, South of Range 1 East. lying
South and South West of Yellow Leaf
Creek. Containing 30 Acres more or less.
