Whereas *Elias Moore, of Shelly County, Missouri,*has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Shelby Co., Mo.*, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

*Elias Moore,* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North West quarter of the East half of the North West quarter, the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section eighteen, and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Nine, in Township twenty-one, of Range twelve, in the District of Land subject to sale by the General Survey, containing two hundred acres, and thirty three hundredths of an acre;

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Elias Moore,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

*Elias Moore,*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Elias Moore,*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
