Wyatt Bevill according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of the South West quarter of Section thirty six Township nineteen of Range two East in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing eighty acres and Twenty one acre and a half hundredths of one acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Wyatt Bevill

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Wyatt Bevill


