To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Edward M. Brown* of the State of *Ohio*, by *his attorney, J. H. Brown*, of the County of *Cuyahoga*, State of *Ohio*, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Cleveland*, Ohio, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Edward M. Brown* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 3rd of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the purchase of the *Section 17* of the *Quarter Section 36* of the *Range 14* of the *Meridian 11* West of the *Principal Meridian*, in the *County of Cuyahoga*, State of *Ohio*, and that the said *Edward M. Brown* has been paid according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Edward M. Brown*.

Now KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Edward M. Brown*, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Edward M. Brown*, his heirs and assigns forever.
