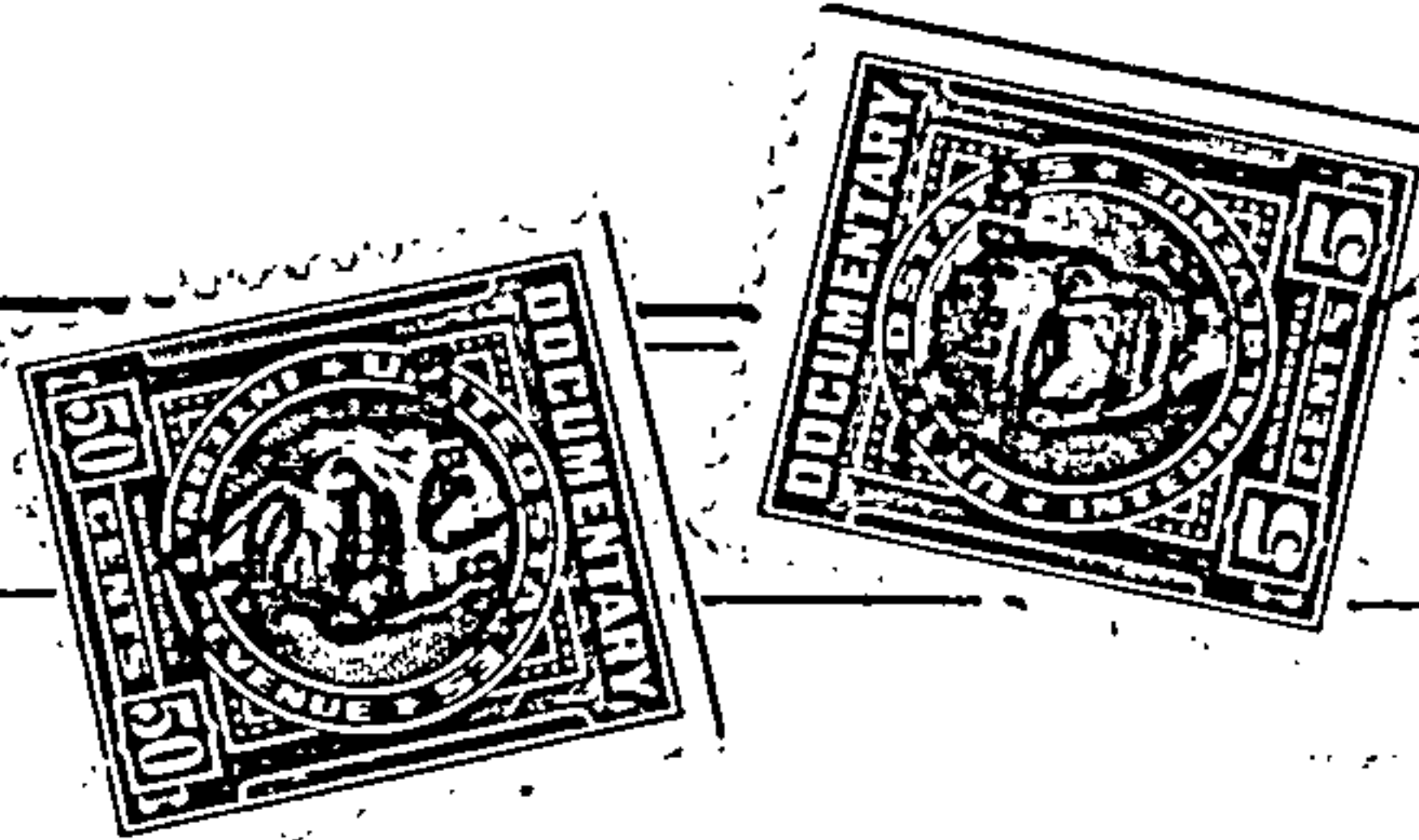

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James A. Campbell

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Ala., to-wit:

The sufrage right to 6 acres of land described as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the

Northwest Quarter of Section M 17, Township 21, Range 3 West, and

run thence east along the south line of said forty a distance of 420

feet to an iron stob for a point of beginning of the lands hereinafter

described: run thence east along the south line of said forty a distance

of 630 feet to an iron stob; run thence north a distance of 420 feet to

an iron stob; run thence west and parallel to the south line of said

forty a distance of 630 feet to an iron stob; run thence south a

distance of 420 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, and
