My name is marshall D. Parker. I am well acquainted with the land described as the W¹/₄ of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ and the W¹/₂ of the NW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄, Section 32 Twp 18 R 1 E in Shelby County, Ala. I have seen an abstract of that certain deed recorded in Deed Book 123 at page 362 of the records of the probate Judge of Shelby County wherein George Huddleston and wife Bertha purportedly conveyed to W A Belcher lumber Co the W¹/₂ of the NW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ of said section 32 together with certain other lands. ^{my wife and I} are the owners of said above described W¹/₂ of the NW¹/₄ and the W¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄ of said section 32. We own to my wife and this day conveying said land which we own to Josephine T Cleal for the sum of twelve hundred ^{fifty} dollars by deed dated Sept 24 th 1952. For the purpose of inducing Josephine T Cleal to purchase said lands and to pay my wife and me Said twelve hundred ⁷⁵ Dollars I hereby certify to them that no part of the lands known as the W¹/₂ of the SW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ ever belonged to George Huddleston or W A Belcher lumber Co and that the deed recorded in Deed Book 123 at page 362 hereinbefore mentioned is void in so far as the same purports to convey the W¹/₂ of the NW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ of said section 32 Twp 18 Range 1 East. I further certify for said purpose that said lands have been in the open continuous and adverse possession of my family to the exclusion of all others for more than fifty years and more than thirty years to my own certain knowledge.
