Atkinson on January 8, 1889, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 22 Page 433 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, which deed, among other land, conveyed the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 34, Township 21 Range 1 East. J. D. Atkinson, the grantor in said deed, was my Uncle. To the best of my recollection, he has been dead for approximately 15 years. He was married three times during his life but all of his wives are dead and the one who last died has been dead for approximately ten years. I know of my own knowledge that J. D. Atkinson is one and the same person as Davis Atkinson who purchased an interest in said land.

I understand that W. C. Atkinson and wife, Nora Atkinson, conveyed said land, along with other lands, to W. J. Atkinson on January 15, 1889, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 22 Page 435 in said Probate Office. Nora Atkinson was my Aunt and I know of my own knowledge that she is one and the same person as N. G. Atkinson, who was shown to have signed said deed. The said W. C. Atkinson was my Uncle and to my best recollection, he died some 30 years ago and his wife, Nora Atkinson died approximately 25 years ago. Both of them were living in Texas when they died.
