To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS John Johnson of the City of Boston,
had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at the expiration of his lease,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Johnson,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the lands of the United States, except in case of State or Territorial Government, or before 1820,
that in the district of the said tract, no survey or description of the same
and no right or claim to the same has been taken, or any claim or interest therein has been reserved
according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said John Johnson,

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John Johnson,
the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said John Johnson
and his heirs and assigns forever.
