and other valuable considerations

the receipt whereof is acknowledged We the said Waverly Hall and Helen Hall

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Alberta W. George

the following described real estate, situated in Shelby
County, Alabama, to-wit:All that part of Section 24, Township 19, Range 1 East, described as follows: From a point on the South line of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, which point is 825 feet East of the Southwest corner of such NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, run North parallel to the North and South center line of Section 24 to the South line of highway right of way; thence East along such right of way to the North and South center line of Section 24; thence South to the Southeast corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence West 495 feet to the point of beginning, containing 15 acres more or less and situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
