AFFIDAVIT OF MARY GRILL

Mary Grill, being duly sworn to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Mary Grill and I live at 400 S.W. ^{13th} ~~14th~~ Street, in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. I was married to Frank Grill who died in April, 1927. He died leaving no will and testament and no administration was made of his estate as none was needed. Prior to his death, he conveyed all his real property to me and at the time of his death he had no assets. He left no debts other than last illness expenses and burial expenses which have been paid in full.

Frank Grill left surviving him a widow, namely, Mary Grill and three sons, namely, Frank Ferdinand Grill, August Andrew Grill, and John George Grill. The said three sons are over the age of twenty-one years. Frank Ferdinand Grill and August Andrew Grill are not and have never been married; John George Grill is married to Josephine Grill. Frank Grill left surviving him no other child or children and no descendant or descendants of any deceased child or children.

My deceased husband conveyed to me

Blocks 12, 21 and 22 according to the map of Birmingham Acreage Company's First Subdivision being in Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, a map of which subdivision is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, on February 16, 1927, said deed being recorded in Volume 79, page 405 in the office of the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

My deceased husband purchased the above described property from the Birmingham Acreage Company on lease sale contract on October 17, 1910, and received a deed to said property on January 4, 1912, said deed being recorded in Volume 47, at pages 616-18 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

My deceased husband up until the time of his death and

since his death I have paid taxes on said property up to and including the year 1951.
