Affiant further states that he <sup>did not</sup> know Robert Seale in his life time <sup>but</sup> ~~and also~~ knew Mary Jane Seale, who was the widow of Robert Seale, and Mary Jane Seale is the same person as Mary J. Seale and M. J? Seale.

That affiant knows Green Seale and he is the same person as G. A. Seale and is the son of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale, and that Jennett Ann Seale is one and the same person as Jinnette Ann Seale and Jinnete Seale and she is the wife of Green Seale; that Emma McGiboney is the daughter of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale, and the wife of Frank McGiboney, who is one and the same person as G. F. McGiboney; that Callie Arnett is the daughter of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale and the wife of W. T. Arnett; that Dora Curlee is one and the same person as Madora Curlee, is the daughter of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale and wife of L. N. Curlee; that Mary Jane Seale was the widow of Robert Seale on the 10th day of August, 1894, the said Mary Jane Seale being now dead and left no will disposing of any property she might have owned; that Bell Seale and Martha Seale were the daughters of the said Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale and were unmarried on the 10th day of August, 1894; and the above named persons except Mary Jane Seale the wife of Robert Seale compose the names of all the children of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale, except C. A. Merrell who was a daughter of said Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale and Mrs. Barney Armstrong, who was also the daughter of Robert Seale and Mary Jane Seale and who died prior to August 10, 1894 and left surviving her one child, Thomas Armstrong, whose name is signed by his father, Barney Armstrong to the deed described on page 2 of the abstract. Affiant further

states that Barney Armstrong, the husband of Mrs. Barney Armstrong and the father of Thomas Armstrong is now dead.

Affiant further states that he knew the firm of Averyt and Averyt who were doing business in Shelby, Shelby County, Alabama, on the 23rd day of November, 1897, the said firm was a partnership composed of G. H. Averyt and J. F. Averyt doing business under said firm name of Averyt & Averyt, and that Lookie E. Averyt was the wife of G. H. Averyt, and Ella N. Averyt was the wife of J. F. Averyt.
