


STATE OF ALABAMA,

C. Walker, Chairman, T. R. Nash, J. H. Thompson, Offie Stinson and Fred McClendon.

"T. R. Nash introduced and read the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Wilson Durden and wife, Nannie Dee Durden, Henry Tyson and wife, Lurline Tyson, Lawrence Garrett and wife, Mildred Garrett and J. C. Garrett, Jr. and wife, Mary Ollie Garrett have presented to the Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control the following paper in writing and have requested that the Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County assent to such vacation by adopting a resolution for this purpose. Said instrument is as follows:

STATE OF ALABAMA,
SHELBY COUNTY.

WHEREAS, in years past the location of U. S. Highway No. 31 in Sections 28 and 29 of Township 21 South, Range 2 West, has been altered and a small strip of road formerly used has for many years been abandoned and is no longer used by the public; and

WHEREAS, each of the undersigned parties owns a portion of the land which abutts this abandoned strip of roadway, which roadway is described as follows:

Commencing at a right of way marker at Station 754/38.6 on U. S. Highway 31; thence northerly 414 feet to the point of beginning where the herein described county road intersects U. S. Highway 31 on west side; thence in a southerly direction 0.62 miles to point of ending where said county road again intersects U. S. Highway 31 at a point 1.27 mile north of the Dargin Cross road.

Said county road is lying in Sections 28 and 29, Township 21 South, Range 2 West;

and

WHEREAS, if said abandoned road is vacated such vacation will not deprive other property owners of such right as they may have to convenient and reasonable means of ingress and egress

to and from their property.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, the undersigned owners of the land abutting on said abandoned road desire the same to be vacated and they do by executing this instrument declare the same to be vacated as provided for by Title 56, Section 32 of the Code of Alabama, 1940.
