My name is Annie L. Bell. I am the widow of T. W. Bell who, during his lifetime owned the following described land:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

Said land having been purchased by him on January 28, 1920, from Mrs. M. L. Kidd, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 124 Page 344 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. I first came to Vincent in the year 1905 and from that time until the present day, I know of my own knowledge that none of Mr. T. W. Bell's brothers or sisters or other relatives claimed any interest or had any deed to the above described land. I also know that Mrs. M. L. Kidd owned and claimed said land from the year 1915 until she sold the same to my husband, as shown above. From the time he purchased it until this very day he, and since his death, I have been in continuous and actual possession of it and have been cultivating parts of it or having it cultivated by tenants each and every year and no one has ever disputed our title or contested our possession. Some of T. W. Bell's relatives did own some of the forties adjoining the above described land, but they have never owned the above described land.
