

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, Harold G. Harrison, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared R. L. Holcombe, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is R. L. Holcombe. I am also known as Robert L. Holcombe. I am one and the same person who purchased Block 254 Dunstan's Map of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, along with other property, from Alabama Lime & Stone Corporation on July 16, 1929, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 92 Page 325 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. At said time and in connection with said transaction, I was acting as the agent for Holcombe Mercantile Company, Inc. On May 6, 1931, I, as said agent, conveyed to Coosa Land Company said land along with other lands, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 92 Page 327 in said Probate Office. At said time I was acting as agent for said Holcombe Mercantile Company, Inc. Affiant further says that Holcombe Mercantile Company was incorporation in March 1916 and that said affiant, along with Edgar M. Holcombe and Jasper Holcombe owned all of the stock of said corporation. Affiant further says that in September 1938, when said corporation was dissolved as shown by Corporation Record 3 Page 291 in said Probate Office, said affiant was the owner of all of the capital stock of said corporation and as such was entitled to any real estate which said corporation owned at the time of said dissolution. Affiant further says that prior to the date said corporation was dissolved, the said Jasper Holcombe, being one and the same person as Jasper Holcombe, Sr. died and the said Edgar M. Holcombe also died. On the date said corporation was dissolved, the sole and surviving heirs at law of Jasper Holcombe and Edgar M. Holcombe were, namely: affiant Robert L. Holcombe, Jasper Holcombe, Jr., Kate H. Cowart, Ettye L. Bowdon and Lucy H. Salter, all of whom are now living and are over the age of twenty-one years and are of sound mind.
