

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, T Virginia Johnson, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Mary Cost, who after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Mary Cost. I am 74 years of age. I am a sister of Walter M. Cost, Henry Cost, Cordria Cost and Russell P. Cost. My said brothers and sister and I are the sole and surviving heirs at law of J. H. Cost, deceased. Walter M. Cost was an unmarried man and he died without leaving a Will on March 6, 1949. Henry Cost was an unmarried man and he died without leaving a Will on December 20, 1949. Cordria Cost and R. P. Cost and I were the sole and surviving heirs at law of Walter M. Cost and Henry Cost. On August 15, 1952, Cordia Cost, being one and the same person as Cordria Cost; R. P. Cost, being one and the same person as Russell P.
