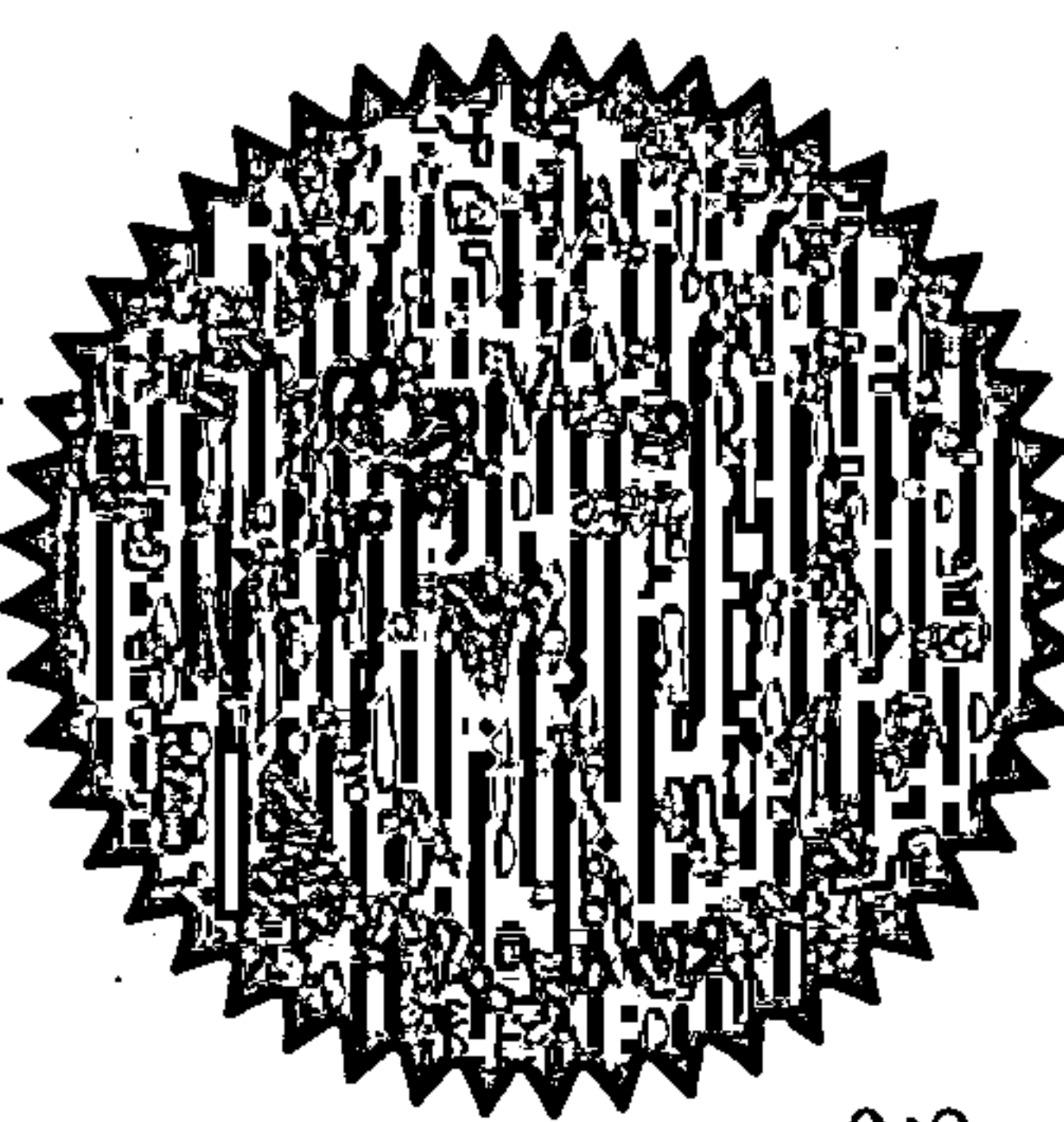
Witness Isaac H. Mason of Shelby County, Alabama

had deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Montgomery Alabama

whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Isaac H. Mason according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the double tract quarter of the south east quarter of section thirty four, in Township twenty one South of Range one East of Mountville Meridian, in Alabama, containing thirty six acre land twenty five hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Isaac H. Mason

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents Do give and grant, unto the said Isaac H. Mason and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, hereunto belonging, unto the said Isaac H. Mason and to his heirs and assigns forever.

have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
