whereby it appears that Full Payment has been made by the said Edwin J. Netherly according

to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the south west quarter of section thirty four, in township twenty south, of range one west of Shontville Meridian in Alabama, containing one hundred and fifty even acres and sixty eight hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Edwin J. Netherly

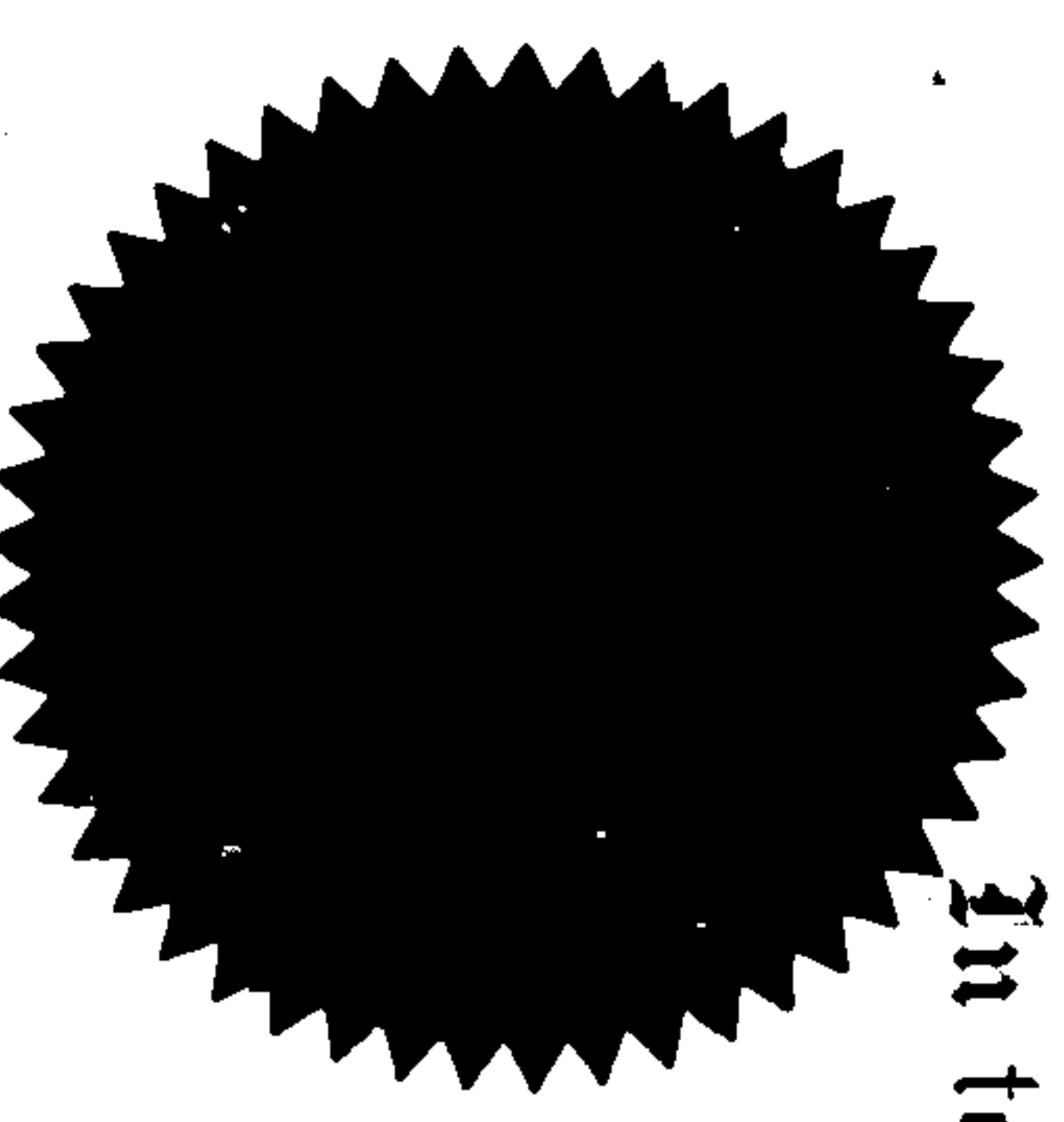
Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents Do give and grant, unto the said Edwin J. Netherly and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Edwin J. Netherly and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Chester A. Arthur, President of the United States of America,

have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
