 Whereas There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemented thereto, the claim of James W. Cornell, _____ has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the amount and quantity of Section Twenty Six, in Township Twenty Four North, Range Fifteen East of St. Stephen's Meridian in Sherman County, containing one hundred and thirty acres, and sitting six hundred and thirty of said acre, _____

according to the Official Order of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said William H. Overmire,
the tract of Land above described. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances
thereto, unto the said William H. Overmire and to his
heirs and assigns forever.

My testimony whereof, I, Richard A. Mitchell, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
