TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING.

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of an Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847, *Oliph Green, Father and heir at law of John Green, deceased, late a private in Company C 1st Battalion Arkansas Volunteers.*

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *his* favor, numbered *35644.*

There is therefore granted by the United States unto *the said Oliph Green, and to his heirs, the North East quarter of Section Twenty, in Township Twenty four of Range fourteen East in the District of Kansas subject to sale at auction, all claims, containing one hundred and fifty feet and fifty five hundredths of an acre.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office, by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract had been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Oliph Green, and to his* heirs and assigns forever.
