LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF W. M. VINES

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN.

I, W. M. Vines, of the County and State aforesaid, being of sound mind and memory, but mindful of the uncertainties of life and wishing to make definite disposition of what property I may have at my death, do hereby make, publish and declare this as and for my Last Will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former wills and testaments by me made.

ITEM I

I direct my Executrix to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my death as may be convenient, from any money or property that I may have at the time of my death.

ITEM II

All the rest and residue of my property of every kind whatsoever, which I may now own, or may hereafter acquire, I will, devise and bequeath to my daughter, Mary Vines Corley Wright; but if my said daughter shall predecease me, then such property is to go to her child or children living at my death; and in case there should be no such child or children living at that time, then all of said property is to be equally divided between SOUTHERN BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY, Of Louisville, Kentucky, and FURMAN UNIVERSITY, of Greenville, South Carolina.

ITEM III

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my daughter, Mary Vines Corley Wright as sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and I direct that my said Executrix shall not be required to give any bond or security as such or to make any accounting to any court of her acts as Executrix nor shall she be required to file any inventory in any court of any of the assets of my estate. I hereby give my said Executrix full power and authority to

sell any or all of my property of every kind, wherever located, with the power and right to make conveyances and deeds as effectually to pass the title to the property belonging to my estate as if it had been done during my lifetime.
