I knew Mrs. Eva LaSalle during her lifetime. She at one time owned and lived upon the above described lands with adjacent lands, having bought same from Harry Gordon and J.R. White about the year 1936.

The said Mrs. Eva LaSalle is now dead and left surviving her as her sole heirs at law, a daughter, Mrs. Rossie Wakeland, whose husband is W.E. Wakeland, and one son, Woodrow W. Stone, who is also known as W.W. Stone.

I have been shown the deed from Mrs. Wakeland and her husband and Woodrow Stone and his wife to H.M. Gould, dated February 26, 1953, and I know the signature thereto to be that of Woodrow W. Stone, and that he is one and the same as the Woodrow W. Stone mentioned in the body of said deed as one of the heirs of Mrs. Eva LaSalle and also one and the same person as ~~WOODROW W. STONE~~ W.W. Stone, who acknowledged said deed on the 4th day of March, 1953 before G.E. McLaurine.
