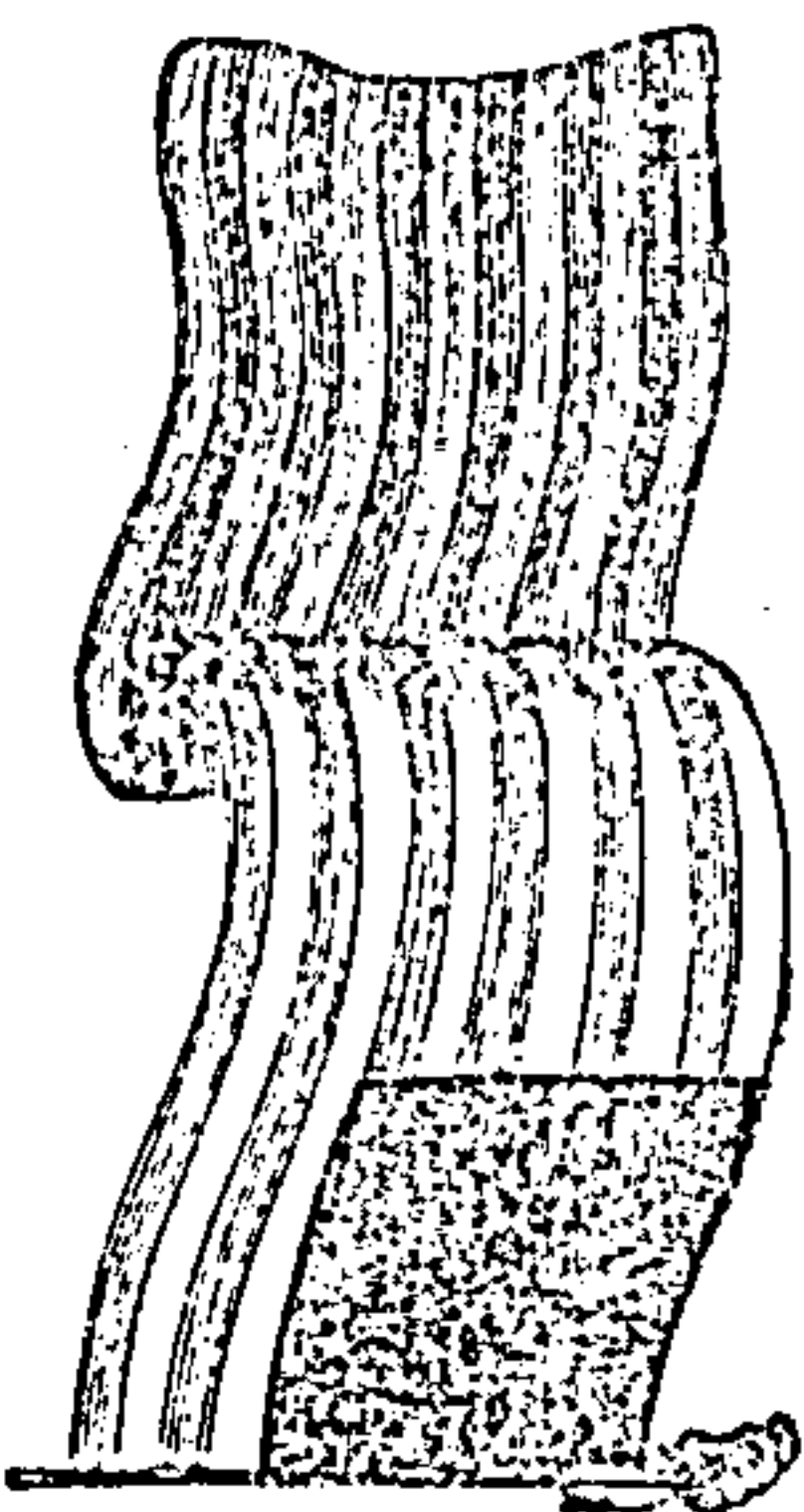




THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved MARCH 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrent No. 157818 for 80 acres, in favor of Willis Chapinell, Private, Captain Jackson's Company, Tennessee Militia, War 1812

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North half of the North East quarter of section twelve, in Township twenty-four, of Range Eleven East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Chasacalorra, Alabama, containing eighty one acres and twenty four hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, the said Warrent having been assigned by the said Willis Chapinell to Joseph K. John in whom favor said tract has been located

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Joseph K. John as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph K. John as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever.
