TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Abel P. Hughes has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the north half of the north west quarter and the north half of the north east quarter of section thirty-two in township twenty south of range one west of Kintaville Meridian in Alabama containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and thirty hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Abel P. Hughes the tract of Land above described TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Abel P. Hughes and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
