To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Leander Bardin of Shelby County, Alabama*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Tuscaloosa* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Leander Bardin*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the *South East quarter of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty-eight, in Township twenty-four of Range fifteen, East, in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing seventy-nine acres and ninety-two hundredths of an acre.*

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Leander Bardin*

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Leander Bardin*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Leander Bardin*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
