To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

REPORTS *Corrected*, *Amended*, or *Altered*. Having
been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States as certificate of the Register of the Land Office at St. Louis,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Government thereof,
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 8th of April, 1890, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the said tract Grant presents up the North West quarter of Section eleven, Town
= ship twenty-two, Range one, East, in the District of Texas subject to sale at
Public Sale, *at St. Louis*, containing thirty acres and eighty six acres which
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Government.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the
second act of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Government
and to its heirs, assigns, administrators, executors, and assigns forever, the right, privilege, immunity and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said
Government.

To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said
Government.
