To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Richard Rogers, of Shelby County, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Richard Rogers, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 28th of April, 1880, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the first half of the fourth quarter of Section 20, in Township 20 North, Range 10 East, in the District of Lower Alabama, subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, containing seventy nine acres, and eighty one hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Richard Rogers

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Richard Rogers, and to his heirs, assigns, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the place and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, therunto belonging unto the said Richard Rogers

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made, Signed, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
