Whereas John W. Williams, of Shelby County, Alabama,

John W. Williams, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North East quarter and the North West quarter of the South East quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter and the West half of the South West quarter of Section eight, in Township twenty-two, of Range one East, in the District of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing two hundred acres and eighty hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said John W. Williams.

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said John W. Williams,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

John W. Williams and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, J. James Buchanan, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
