To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS Charles Coleman of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Charles Coleman according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1889, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty Three, in Township Twenty one of Range one West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing thirty one acres and eighty five and a half hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Charles Coleman

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Charles Coleman and to his heirs forever, all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said Charles Coleman

Do have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said Charles Coleman and to his heirs forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, has caused these Letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
