according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the public lands," for the East half of the North East quarter of Section Twenty-two, in Township Twenty-one, of Range Eleven, in the District of Nebraska and State of Nebraska, containing eighty acres and containing hereunto

of our own accord according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been previously located by the said Joseph Howard

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Joseph Howard and his heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Joseph Howard and his heirs and assigns forever.
