To all to whom these presents shall come, Greetings:

Whereas Richmond Mervell, of Shelby County, Alabama,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa,

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Richmond Mervell,
according to the provisions of the
Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the East half of the North West fractional Quarter; and the East
half of the South West fractional Quarter, (or Fraction C.) of
Section Twenty Three, in Township Twenty two, of Range One,
East, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa,
Alabama, containing One Hundred acres, and twenty five
hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL,
which said tracts have been purchased by the said Richmond Mervell,

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case
made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Richmond Mervell,

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Richmond Mervell
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
