

GENERAL LAND OFFICE

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Thomas Langille, of Kelly county,  
had appeared in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Land Office at Muskogee,  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Thomas Langille,  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the South - West fraction of Section twenty-two, in Township twenty-nine, Range one, East,  
in the District of Lands offered for sale at Muscogee, Alabama, containing one hundred  
and twenty-six acres, and twenty-eight hundredths of an acre,  
according to the official plan of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been plun-  
ched by the said Thomas Langille.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several  
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Thomas Langille,  
and to his heirs, the said tract above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appur-  
tenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Thomas Langille,  
and to his  
heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, John Quincy Adams,  
President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be annexed  
affixed.

Given under my hand, at the city of Washington, the first day of December, in the year of our  
Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, and of the Independence of the United States the  
fifty-first.
