Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Ten, in Township Twenty Two, of Range One, West, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Thirty nine acres, and ninety nine and a half hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jackson Porter;

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

Jackson Porter,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
