according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North East quarter of the North East quarter and North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section ten, in Township twenty two, of Range one, West, in the District of Lurds, subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, et al una, containing Twenty nine acres, and ninety nine hundred and eight of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jackson Porter,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Jackson Porter,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Jackson Porter

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
