Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section thirty four, in Township twenty one, of Range One, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing Forty Acres, and sixty seven and a half hundredths of an Acre,

and to his heirs and assigns forever
