Gentlemen:

Complying with request from your Assistant County Engineer, Mr. J. L. Ray, you are hereby authorized to remove a quantity of clay-gravel estimated to be 20,000 cubic yards from a pit on property of Tennessee Coal & Iron Division, United States Steel Corporation in the North-East quarter of South-East quarter of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, for use in connection with your Project SACP 460-A, Shelby County, upon the following conditions:

- (1) The removal of said clay-gravel shall be performed in a manner satisfactory to the Tennessee Coal & Iron Division, United States Steel Corporation. No clay-gravel is to be removed below the finished grade level of the adjacent road and when the work is completed the pit shall be free from depressions and self-drained to the satisfaction of this company.
- (2) The Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County shall protect and save harmless the Tennessee Coal & Iron Division, United States Steel Corporation from all loss, damage, cost or expense which it may sustain as a result of this operation.
- (3) The authority herein granted shall become effective on the 1st day of April, 1953, and shall expire on the 31st day of December, 1953, but may be terminated at any time prior to said date upon thirty (30) days' written notice from Tennessee Coal & Iron Division, United States Steel Corporation.
- (4) The Board of Revenue and Control of Shelby County shall keep an accurate account of all clay-gravel removed from said location and shall pay the Tennessee Coal & Iron Division, United States Steel Corporation at the rate of Five Cents (5¢) per cubic yard for all clay-gravel removed from said location and payment shall be made on or before January 15, 1954, for all clay-gravel removed during the term of this contract.
